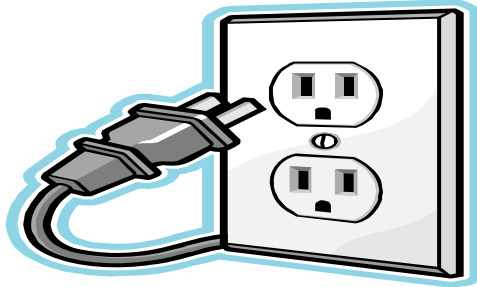


Keeping You Apartment Safe – The Do's and Don'ts of Using Extension Cords



- Do** - Be sure the cord is not damaged
- Do** - Keep prongs straight and not bent
- Do** - Replace your cords regularly
- Do** - Fasten cord to the baseboard with appropriate fastener
- Do** - Use a surge protector for major appliances
- Do** - Keep walking areas clear of cords

- Don't** - Plug extension cords together
- Don't** - Force a three pronged plug into to two prong outlet
- Don't** - Fasten your cords to the wall with a sharp object
- Don't** - Use a cord that is frayed or otherwise damaged
- Don't** - Let cords become a tripping hazard
- Don't** - Use a cord that has sparked
- Don't** - Use a cord on a major appliance
